

ORDINANCE # 1-88

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HARRISVILLE, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE HARRISVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND OTHER WORKING AT THEIR REQUEST AND UNDER THEIR DIRECTION TO UTILIZE SUCH MECHANICAL, ELECTRICAL OR ELECTRONIC DEVICES TO TIME THE RATE OF SPEED OF VEHICLES WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF HARRISVILLE AS MAY BE PERMITTED BY THE LAWS OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Harrisville has a police department charged with the enforcement of the speed laws as set forth by Harrisville Borough Council; and


WHEREAS, Harrisville Borough Council has deemed it advisable under the provisions of the Vehicle Code 75 Pa.C.S. §3368 and the regulations issued thereunder to permit the Harrisville Police Department to utilize speed timing devices such as permitted by law in the enforcement of the vehicle speed regulations within the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Harrisville Borough Council, and it is hereby ORDAINED AND ENACTED by authority of the same as follows:


1. The Harrisville Police Department and others acting at their request and under their direction may utilize any mechanical, electrical or electronic speed timing device permitted by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code for local authorities including, but not limited to, vascar.
2. The Mayor or in his absence, the Chief of Police, or designated officer in charge of the Borough of Harrisville, shall take custody of any such equipment supplied by the Harrisville Borough Council, and shall utilize the same in conformity with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code and the regulations issued thereunder for the more effective enforcement of the speed regulations in the Borough of Harrisville, Butler County, Pennsylvania.
3. This ordinance shall be effective immediately.
