

ORDINANCE NO. 1-99

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HARRISVILLE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2-97 RELATIVE TO PROHIBITING DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE; PROCEDURES FOR LICENSED, UNLICENSED AND THREATENING DOGS; AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.


The Borough of Harrisville hereby ordains:


Section 8 of Ordinance No. 2-97: is hereby amended and shall read as follows:


Section 8. Penalties. The first violation whereby a dog is seized, the Owner shall pay a fine of \$50.00 to the Borough as well as reasonable fees for keeping the animal in a kennel as fixed pursuant to a resolution of the Borough. The second time a dog is seized for violation of this Ordinance, the Owner shall pay a fine of \$100.00 to the Borough as well as reasonable fees for keeping the animal in a kennel as fixed pursuant to a resolution of the Borough.

Any person allowing a dog to run at large a third time in violation of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$600.00; in default of payment, to imprisonment for term not to exceed 30 days; as well as pay reasonable fees for keeping the animal in a kennel as fixed pursuant to a resolution of the Borough.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective on January 4, 1999.
