**ORDINANCE NO. 01 OF 2007**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HARRISVILLE, BUTLER COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5 OF 2004 TO PROHIBIT THE USE  
OF COMPRESSION RELEASE ENGINE BRAKES IN THE BOROUGH**

The Borough Council of Harrisville, Butler County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the authority granted to it by the Pennsylvania Second-Class Township Code, hereby ORDAINS AND ENACTS as follows:

SECTION 1. Article II, Section 2.02 of Ordinance 2 of 2004 which prohibits unnecessary noises within the Borough is hereby amended to add to Section 2.02 thereof a new Subsection F which reads as follows:

- F. The use of compression release engine brakes (commonly referred to as "Jake Brakes") on any motor vehicle operated within the Borough is prohibited except when the use of the same is necessary for the safe operation of the vehicle.

SECTION 2. Any existing Resolution or Ordinance, or part thereof, conflicting with any part of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent inconsistent herewith.

This Ordinance is enacted this 5th day of November, 2007 and shall be effective five (5) days following the said date of enactment.
