**ORDINANCE NO. 01 OF 2008**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION OF A STOP SIGN ON HENRY STREET WHERE THE SAME INTERSECTS CONSTITUTION STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF HARRISVILLE, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the safety of traffic, persons and property within the Borough that a stop sign be erected on Henry Street at the intersection of Constitution Street in the Borough of Harrisville, Butler County, Pennsylvania.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the Harrisville Borough Council as follows:-

- Section 1. Henry Street, as the same intersects with Constitution Street, is hereby established as a stop intersection.
- Section 2. An official stop sign shall be placed in such a position so as to face traffic traveling west on Henry Street as the same approaches the intersection of Constitution Street.
- Section 3. All vehicles approaching Constitution Street in a westbound direction on Henry Street shall come to a full stop within a reasonable distance before entering Constitution Street.
- Section 4. Any operator of a vehicle who shall fail to come to a full stop as set forth above shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$35.00 plus costs of prosecution.
- Section 5. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances not in accordance with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as not in accordance herewith.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon enactment.
