

ORDINANCE NO. 2-85

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HARRISVILLE, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING PARKING RESTRICTIONS UPON AND ALONG MAIN STREET IN THE BOROUGH, PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF SIGNS SETTING FORTH SAID RESTRICTIONS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Harrisville, after inspections and engineering studies, have determined that certain parking restrictions are necessary for the promotion of the orderly regulation of traffic within said Borough and for the promotion of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Borough;

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, be it ordained and enacted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Harrisville, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I

Chapter XIV, Section 35, of the Code of Ordinances, Borough of Harrisville, is hereby repealed.

SECTION II

The Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Harrisville is hereby amended by including in Chapter XIV the following sections:

Section 35: Two-Hour Parking Established. No person shall park at or upon the following streets for more than two (2) consecutive hours:

<u>STREET</u>	<u>SIDE</u>	<u>BETWEEN</u>
Main Street	East and West	Prairie Street and Mercer Street
Main Street	West	Mercer Street and Henry Street

Section 36: Penalty for Violation. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Article (Sections 31 to 35 of this Chapter) shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in accordance with the provisions of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code.

### SECTION III

The President of Council shall have the authority to designate the person or persons responsible for erecting sign posts required by law and regulation to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.

### SECTION IV

All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent herewith.
