

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 2-86 - SEWER USE ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART I - MANDATORY CONNECTION - SECTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF 86 - SEWER USE ORDINANCE - WHEREBY THE TIME FOR CONNECTION IS AMENDED AS REGARDS TO SEWER USE IN THE BOROUGH OF HARRISVILLE, COUNTY OF BUTLER, STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough Harrisville as follows:

PART I - MANDATORY CONNECTION AMENDMENT

Section 1: The following paragraph shall be the amended version of Section 1.1 of ordinance no. 2 of 86 - Sewer Use Ordinance - reflecting the change therein:

The owner(s) of all houses, buildings or other structures used for human occupancy, recreation or other purposes, situated within the Borough of Harrisville, which abut any street, alley or right of way in which a public sanitary sewer is located, are hereby required to connect to the public sanitary sewer system within thirty (30) days after receipt of official notice to connect.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby deemed to repealed to the extent of the inconsistency and for the purposes of enforcement of this amendment.

This ordinance shall be effective as of March 1, 1993, ORDAINED AND ENACTED this 1st day of March, 1993.
