

ORDINANCE NO. 2-87

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HARRISVILLE, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF HARRISVILLE BOROUGH BY ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT UPON BROWNTOWN STREET AND AMENDING THE PENALTIES FOR ALL SPEED LIMIT VIOLATIONS WITHIN THE BOROUGH.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED and IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Harrisville, Butler County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION I.

CHAPTER XIV part 2 §12 of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Harrisville, Butler County, Pennsylvania, is hereby amended, altered and continued to read as follows:

Section 12. Speed limits established: The following speed limits are hereby established:

<u>HIGHWAY</u>	<u>BETWEEN</u>	<u>SPEED LIMIT</u>
1. Franklin Street	Station 0 + 00 at Mercer Street & Station 21+00	40 mph
	Station 1273+94 to Station 1230+00	35 mph
2. W.Mercer Street	Franklin Street and West Borough line	35 mph
3. W.Prairie Street	Franklin Street and Constitution Avenue	15 mph
4. Browntown Street	PA traffic Route 8 and the Borough line	45 mph
5. All others	For entire extent	25 mph

Any person who shall operate a vehicle at a speed in excess of that established therefor, upon a highway specified in this section, shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced in accordance with the provisions of Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, as amended.

SECTION II.

Any Ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.
