**Ordinance No.** 02-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HARRISVILLE,  
BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING  
PAPER ALLEY.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Harrisville desires Paper Alley to be annulled and vacated;  
and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the safety of traffic, persons and property within the  
Borough of Harrisville to vacate Paper Alley.

NOW, THEREFORE, Harrisville Borough Council hereby ordains and enacts the  
following Ordinance:

SECTION 1. Subject. Harrisville Borough hereby annuls and vacates Paper Alley  
extending from the west side of Main Street to the east side of Church Street, bounded and  
described as follows:

Beginning at a point, which point is the intersection of the east side of  
an alley and west side of Main Street thence South 87° 57' 00" East, a  
distance of 179.97 feet to a point; thence North 1° 00' 00" West, a  
distance of 20.05 feet to an iron pin; thence North 87° 57' 00" West, a  
distance of 179.97 feet to point; thence South 1° 00' 00" East, a  
distance of 20.05 feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2. Effect. Pursuant to this Ordinance, all public rights of travel and all public  
duties of maintenance and repair are hereby vacated and terminated.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances not in accordance with  
this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as not in accordance herewith.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and  
after its passage and publication according to law.
