**ORDINANCE NO. 02 OF 2007**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PORTION OF DRENNING STREET AS A ONE-  
WAY STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF HARRISVILLE, BUTLER COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA**

The Borough Council of Harrisville, Butler County, Pennsylvania, hereby ORDAINS AND ENACTS as follows:

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the safety of traffic, persons and properties within the Borough of Harrisville that a portion of Drenning Street be established as a one-way street.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the Borough Council of the Borough of Harrisville, Butler County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained as follows:

SECTION 1. That portion of Drenning Street extending from Pennsylvania Route 8, a/k/a South Main Street, on the east to Church Street on the west is hereby established as a one-way street permitting traffic to travel only in a westerly direction thereon.

SECTION 2. Any operator of a vehicle that violates this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of Thirty-Five (\$35.00) Dollars plus costs of prosecution.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances not in accordance herewith are repealed insofar as not in accordance herewith.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon enactment.

This Ordinance is ordained and enacted this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of December, 2007 and shall be effective five (5) days following the said date of enactment.
