

ORDINANCE NO. 5-97

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HARRISVILLE REGULATING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A FOUR WAY STOP INTERSECTION AT THE CORNERS AT EDNA STREET AND HOUSTON AVENUE WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF HARRISVILLE.

The Borough of Harrisville hereby enacts and ordains the following:

1. The following intersection is established to be an intersection needing a four way stop sign and it is hereby ordained that an official stop sign shall be erected in such a position as to proved for a four way stop at the below noted interesection.

Every driver of a vehicle approaching the interesection at the stop sign, in the direction indicated in this case, shall stop the vehicle as required by Sanction 3323(B) of the Vehicle Code, and shall not proceed into or across the said intersection or said street until said vehicle operator has followed all applicable requirements of that section of the motor vehicle code. The section is hereby listed below:



2. Any person who violates any provision of this section, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$25.00 and costs.

3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

4. This ordinance shall be effective on September 8, 1997.
