

**AMENDMENTS TO ORDINANCE NO. 71  
HEALTH AND SANITATION ORDINANCE**

**AND NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Council of the Borough of Harrisville as follows:

SECTION 4 – Grass, Weeds and Certain Other Vegetation to be Removed, Trimmed or Cut.

Section 4.1: Removal of Waste. A new Section 4.1 shall be added to Ordinance No. 71, October 2, 1972, which new Section shall read as follows::

It shall be a violation of this ordinance for any grass, weeds, or any other vegetation or debris removed, trimmed or cut from any property subject to this ordinance to be transferred to, or in any manner be present on or within any Borough street, roadway, alley, or any other public thoroughfare. Owners and occupants of any premises in violation of this ordinance shall be subject to the penalties for violation as set forth in Section 7 of this ordinance.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby deemed to be repealed to the extent of the inconsistency and for the purposes of enforcement of this amendment.

This ordinance shall be effective as of November 4, 2014, **ORDAINED AND ENACTED** this 3rd day of November, 2014.
