ORDINANCE NO. 01 OF 2004

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE HARRISVILLE BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 4
OF 1987 IMPOSING AND ESTABLISHING A SANITARY SEWER CAPACITY TAP
FEE FOR NEW CUSTOMERS CONNECTING TO THE PUBLIC SANITARY SEWERS
IN THE BOROUGH OF HARRISVILLE,**

Section 1.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 4 of 1987, as amended, the Borough of Harrisville established and set the amounts of sewer service charges and connection fees;

WHEREAS, the waste water collected by Harrisville Borough Sanitary Sewer Collection System is treated in the Grove City Borough Waste Water Treatment Facility; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Grove City by Grove City Borough Ordinance No. 1323 of October 20, 2003 enacted and imposed a Sanitary Sewer Service Capacity Fee of \$750.00 per EDU for each new customer connection to the Grove City Borough Waste Water treatment System.

WHEREAS, in order to pass the same on to its Sanitary Sewers customers the Borough of Harrisville intends to enact and impose a capacity tap fee of \$750.00 for each new customer connecting to the Harrisville Borough Sanitary Sewer System.

NOW THEREFORE, it is ordained by the Borough of Harrisville as follows:

1. Section 4 of Harrisville Borough Ordinance 4-1987, as amended, is hereby amended to add at the end thereof the following paragraph:

All owners of property who connect to the public sewer service in the Borough of Harrisville shall pay a Sewer Capacity Tap Fee of \$750.00 per Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU).

2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances not in accordance with this ordinance are hereby repealed and so far as not in accordance herewith.

3. This ordinance shall take affect upon enactment.

Ordained and enacted into an ordinance this 5th day of January 2004.
