

ORDINANCE NO. 6-86 OF 1986

BOROUGH OF HARRISVILLE, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF 1986 BY REPEALING SECTION 1.2 THEREOF REQUIRING CONNECTION TO THE PUBLIC SANITARY SEWER AND PROHIBITING FUTURE ON-LOT SEPTIC SYSTEMS AND PROHIBITING MAJOR REPAIRS TO EXISTING ON-LOT SEPTIC SYSTEMS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Harrisville, Butler County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1

Section 1.2 of Ordinance No. 2 of 1986 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2

Section 1.2 of Ordinance No. 2 of 1986 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Only houses, buildings or other structures that are less than three hundred (300) feet from a public sanitary sewer and that can be served by gravity flow will be required to connect to the public sanitary sewer system. This provision shall not be interpreted as prohibiting the connection of houses, buildings or other structures from connecting to the public sanitary sewer system as long as the owner(s) cover the full cost of the construction and maintenance of the

private sewer laterals, pumps or other facilities required to make such a connection.


- A. There shall be no future construction of on-lot septic systems.
- B. There shall be no major repairs to existing on-lot septic systems. For these purposes a "major repair" is a repair which would require a permit from the sewage enforcement officer.


